Dear EDITH H AJELLO:

Pursuant to Rhode Island General Law 17-25-11(g)(3) you are hereby issued this "Notice of Non-Compliance" as a result of your committee's failure to file its periodic campaign finance report by the due date of October 10, 2006 for the period ending October 9, 2006.

Pursuant to §17-25-11(g)(2), as a consequence of failing to file the required campaign finance report by the due date, you are hereby fined twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and are directed to remit payment along with the required report, if still outstanding, within seven (7) days of the receipt of this "Notice." The report and payment of outstanding fines may be made either "in-person" or by mail and will be considered filed only when the original signed report and remittance have been received at the Board of Elections.

The failure to remit payment and file the required report, if still outstanding, within the seven (7) day period referred to herein shall, pursuant to §17-25-11(g)(3), result in additional fines of two dollars (\$2.00) per day being levied from the day of receipt of this "Notice" until the day the original signed report and remittance have been received at the Board of Elections.

The method of payment for fines shall be by cash, check or money order only. Money orders or checks shall be made payable to: "State of Rhode Island – Internal Service Fund."
